Feedback reports summary and the suggestions of IQAC after analysis

ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT

The alumni feedback was collected and analyzed by IQAC in the following points:

Maximum students agree that college has helped them in building their self confidence, in building their character, in their overall development by giving them great exposure with the help of extracurricular activities with the co-operation and support of the faculty members. Only less than 1% students disagree on the above. But, a major segment (23.4%) believes that they did not avail career counseling and proper guidance for their future from the faculty members and as an outcome many students did not get placements.

Suggestions for Improvements:

*The college should conduct more workshops and orientation programs for the career counseling and guidance of students especially for students of last semester.

TEACHERS' FEEDBACK REPORT

The teacher's feedback was collected online and analyzed by IQAC in the following points: According to majority of the teachers agree to the following points-

Aims and objectives are well defined and clear, course content is in tune with reference materials, reference materials are relevant and updated (approx. 8% teachers disagree with it), sufficient number of prescribed books are available the library, course content fulfills the need of students, fair provisions are there for professional development, sufficient freedom to adopt new teaching techniques etc. But, majority (approx 62 %) believes that there is a need to review the syllabus prescribed.

Suggestions for improvements:

*Teachers should be more participative in filling the survey forms because few teachers have remained neutral throughout and have not presented their views which are very important to enhance their understanding on the teaching learning process for the welfare of the students. *More workshops and sessions should be organized for the teachers on the teaching learning process esp. on NEP so that they get well acquainted with the system requirements.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK REPORT

The students' feedback was collected online and analyzed by IQAC in the following points: Maximum students believe that teachers encourage them to participate in classroom teaching learning process and clearly tell them the programs, course outcomes and learning outcomes. They regularly design different test methods to assess their tearning level, encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities, encourage them for field learning. Teachers take interest in providing their students multiple opportunities and use student centric methods for the better learning and put maximum efforts to enhance soft skills and employability skills of their students.
