The cell aims to identify the weaknesses in the college with respect to the academic, non academic, infrastructural (Technical & Non- Technical), Policy making & other issues and then tries to seek the best solution in view of its capacity & resources . The crucial matters/ issues are forwarded by the Principle to the Management Committee for its approval . The functioning of this committee is based on issuing of notices, holding meetings with various Departments by the Principle/Chairperson and suggesting the innovative & unique ways to improve the quality of the institution w.r.t the overall perspective in view of the available resources.

Another requisition to UGC for the sanctioning of this grant was made 01.06.13 vide letter no. 158//NKM/2013-14

During this session decisions related various aspects included -

Academic- Brochure, admission in UG & PG Courses, Academic calendar, Time —table, co-curricular activities, Innovative practices in the teaching methodology(curriculum being decided by the governing university), Internal assessment in every subject, Annual assessment by the governing university-University of Lucknow, Attendance of students in class & deciding the norm to be satisfied by the student to take university exam, student Feed-back mechanism (in prescribed format)

Non- academic – The college already has NSS & NCC wing doing commendable job and the reports of their activities are taken from time to time. Moreover ,several clubs/groups/Councils are formed besides the already existing ones like- Proctorial Board ,Students Council & Grievance & Redressal Cell, Career counseling Cell of alumni , Parent-Teacher Forum

Decisions related to students progression- extra- curricular activities, cultural events, intra as well as inter-collegiate & inter-university events are taken and addressed as well. Development of In- house Research Activities in U.G & PG students is encouraged. Moreover, arrangement of useful lectures by Mr. Sarvesh Asthana,(Director, Search Foundation working for underprivileged children) related to social issues is made at least twice in a year.

Other decisions are taken as per the various committees's requirements. The infrastructural (technical & non-technical) requirements are met as per the demands made by HODs, students and the management committee approves the decisions taken by the principal.

One major step towards automation of Library through Software was taken and this work was done by Soft Link Asia firm.
